



SENATE BILL #2781

TITLE: Allowing the ASUW President to Appoint Three Executives with the Advice and Consent of the Intersession Oversight Committee

DATE INTRODUCED: February 1, 2022

SPONSORS: Senators Castronovo, Ewalt, and Rhymes; Chief of Legislative Affairs Carrier

1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
2. Student Government is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
3. WHEREAS, currently the ASUW President is allowed to appoint two executives without the
4. advice and consent of the ASUW Senate; and,
5. WHEREAS, this system means that only two ASUW executives can work over the summer
6. session, which is when a substantial portion of the groundwork for a new administration is
7. laid; and,
8. WHEREAS, the ASUW 109th Administration recommends that future administrations hire a
9. Chief of Legislative Affairs to work over the summer session; and,
10. WHEREAS, changing the process to having the Intersession Oversight provide advice and
11. consent instead of the Senate, as opposed to allowing the president to act unilaterally,
12. maintains a system of checks and balances while still allowing this important goal to occur.
13. THEREFORE, be it hereby enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
14. Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government that the ASUW By-Laws be amended to reflect the
15. changes outlined in Addendum A; and,
16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes shall take effect immediately upon
17. enactment of this legislation.

Addendum A

1. Executives

- A. The ASUW President shall have the power to appoint executives to assist with the President's responsibilities with the advice and consent of the ASUW Senate. The ASUW President may appoint ~~two~~ **three** executives without the advice and consent of the ASUW Senate **during times when the ASUW Senate is not in session, but must instead have the advice and consent of the Intersession Oversight Committee.**
- B. Executives are subject to the authority of all ASUW working documents, including, but not limited to, the ASUW Code of Ethics and the standard impeachment procedures.
- C. The ASUW President may remove executives from office, with cause.
