Addendum B

*Our rationale for recommendations

*The Honors College charges an annual \$20.00 fee rather than a fee charged by the credit hour for all of its students.

*The School of Energy Resources charges a \$500.00 one-time fee when taking a mandatory summer course for their students.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current advising fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Agriculture and Life Sciences fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Arts and Sciences fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Business fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Education fee and declined the requested increase from \$26.00 to an amount that was never specified to the Committee in spite of several requests for clarification. The Committee felt that the justification for this proposed increase, to increase spending on mentors stipends would disadvantage the colleges current students when many of those students risk serious financial strain when participating in that program and in the mandatory student-teacher program. In light of this, the Committee rejected the proposed increase from \$26.00 and an unspecified amount.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Engineering and Applied Sciences fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to increase the current Haub School fee from \$20.00 to \$25.00 in light of the need for an increased number of advisors shown to be necessary to maintain that colleges program of excellence. The Haub school is predicated on close work between students and advisors and student outreach to the Committee indicated that the Haub School would not be as effective in its mission without increasing the number of advisors to compensate for increased student involvement with the college.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current Honors College fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.

The ASUW Student Fee Review Committee voted to maintain the current College of Health Sciences fee in light of no request for change and acceptable usage of current funding.
