1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming

2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,

- 3. WHEREAS, the ASUW Rules and Procedures Section 2.04 ASUW Senate Meeting
- 4. Attire sets the standard for required appearance minimums within the Senate Chambers;
- 5. and,
- 6. WHEREAS, Halloween is a globally recognized holiday attended by an expectation of
- 7. frivolity, morale-boosting, team-building, goal-setting, and collaboration that is in
- 8. keeping with ASUW goals; and,
- 9. WHEREAS, Halloween also carries an expectation of various costuming that may or
- 10. may not fall outside of the standards of business casual as specified in the ASUW Rules
- 11. and Procedures; and,
- 12. WHEREAS, the ASUW wishes to partake in the benefits of the holiday without
- 13. violating any specific lines within the ASUW Rules and Procedures.
- 14. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the following clause be added to the ASUW Rules and \
- 15. Procedures as outlined in Addendum A; and,
- 16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes take effect upon the passage of
- 17. this legislation to first be celebrated this 31st of October, 2023.

Addendum A

Section 2.04 ASUW Senate Meeting Attire

- 1. Attire for ASUW business meetings shall be business casual.
- 2. Any year where Halloween falls during the week where a regular ASUW Senate session is held; ASUW Senate Meeting Attire requirements shall be relaxed to include reasonably appropriate Halloween Costumes within the following guidelines:
 - a. Costumes shall not unduly cover the face of the ASUW participant so that their identity is difficult to determine.
 - b. Costumes shall not be unduly revealing in such a manner as to become unprofessional
 - c. Questions regarding the appropriateness of a costume can be cleared by a member of Professional Staff or the ASUW Senate Chairperson, preferably before the ASUW Senate Meeting.
- 2. 3. Breaches of business dress shall be addressed by the ASUW Steering Committee.
