
SENATE BILL# 2909



1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming

- 2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, this bill is incredibly small and the changes are nearly negligible; and,
- 4. WHEREAS, this bill is doing nothing beyond changing a small wording error that
- 5. fundamentally confuses the meaning of Article 7, Section 7.03, Clause 22 which
- 6. currently states that all community programs, except First-Year Senate, "may choose to
- 7. must be required to attend ASUW Senate Meetings on a weekly basis; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, the intent of the bill in which this was created, SB #2841, was to allow
- 9. programs to attend senate sessions OR approved committees.

10. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the original intent of SB #2841 be properly enforced;11. and,

12. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes are reflected in the ASUW

13. Bylaws as outlined in Addendum A; and,

14. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes take effect immediately upon15. passage of this legislation.
