- 1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, as was established in Senate Bill #2853, "WHEREAS, eliminating
- 4. committee and executive verbal communications, except for the President and Vice
- 5. President, shall also help to speed up meetings;" and,
- 6. WHEREAS, this is reflected in our new meeting procedures and the way we conduct
- 7. business but not reflected in the ASUW Rules and Procedures; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, due to this we are technically breaking the ASUW Rules and Procedures
- 9. by not requiring standing committee reports; and,
- 10. WHEREAS, Senate Bill #2853 did choose to retain communications from Ad-Hoc
- 11. Committees which is also not currently being carried out.
- 12. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the ASUW Rules and Procedures be updated to
- 13. properly reflect the changes made in Senate Bill #2853 as outlined in Addendum A; and,
- 14. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes take effect immediately upon the
- 15. passage of this legislation.

- 7. Committee Reports- Steering first, followed by others in alphabetical order, followed by Ad-Hoc Committees.
- 7. Ad-Hoc Committees and Special Committees (Excluding Scholarship Committees)
- 8. College Council- Every representative from each college in attendance shall have the opportunity to provide a report. If a college representative is not in attendance, any reports shall be delivered by the chair of the college council.
