TITLE: Changing the name of the Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee

1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
3. WHEREAS, the current name of the Outreach, Programming, and Elections committee
4. does not reflect what the committee does; and
5. WHEREAS, since this committee has become the committee that handles everything
6. related to Homecoming changing the committee's name to the Homecoming, Outreach,
7. Programming, and Elections Committee would better reflect the responsibilities of this
8. committee; and,
9. WHEREAS, the ASUW by-laws would have to be changed as seen in Addendum A to
10. fully reflect this name change; and,
11. WHEREAS, this has been something the Outreach, Programming, and Elections
12. Committee has been thinking about since Homecoming was added to our jurisdiction.
13. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
14. (ASUW) student government that the Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee
15. will now be referred to as the Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections
16. Committee; and,
17. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the by-laws are changed as seen in the

Article 2. Legislative Branch Section 2.02 The ASUW Senate

10. Standing Committees

H. The ASUW Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee

c. Composition: The committee shall consist of a minimum six (6) ASUW Senators, one (1) of whom shall serve as a chairperson and at least one (1) First-Year Senator. The chair shall not be permitted to run for the position of ASUW President or Vice President in the election that occurs during their time as chair. The committee shall elect a secretary, who will take attendance and take notes for the chair. The ASUW Vice President shall appoint a minimum of one (1) executive to serve as ex-officio on the committee. The ASUW Advisor, or designee, shall serve as advisor.

11. Special Committees

I. Charlotte Hearne Davis Scholarship Committee

c. Composition: The Charlotte Hearne Davis Scholarship will be chaired by the First-Year Senate advisor and will be composed of the Chair of the Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee, the ASUW President (or designee), a designee from the Division of Student Affairs, an ASUW Senator-at-Large, and the ASUW Project Coordinator

B. Low Interaction Governance Groups

a. These groups provide governance which is either internal to ASUW, require little interaction with the public or both. Because of this, these groups are not to be considered priorities for scheduling during the first run-week one priority scheduling block in the Wyoming Union.
