- 1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of
- 2. Wyoming (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible;
- 3. and,
- 4. WHEREAS, Entertainment 7220's Union Fest is a highly anticipated annual
- 5. event featuring a musical act; and,
- 6. WHEREAS, the estimated budget for this act currently stands at roughly
- 7. \$50,000; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, Entertainment 7220 has expressed interest in collaborating with
- 9. ASUW to initiate larger-scale projects for the benefit of students; and,
- 10. WHEREAS, events like Union Fest can be incredibly beneficial to student
- 11. morale and help keep students engaged with their college campus; and,
- 12. WHEREAS, there are a wide range of affordable and well-known acts that could
- 13. be brought to the University of Wyoming campus if ASUW supports Union Fest
- 14. financially; and,
- 15. WHEREAS, these acts are listed in Addendums A and B; and,
- 16. WHEREAS, this collaboration could foster a stronger relationship between
- 17. ASUW and Entertainment 7220; and,
- 18. WHEREAS, this collaboration would also allow both of these entities to work
- 19. together to give students the best experience possible; and,
- 20. WHEREAS, after careful deliberation, the ASUW deadline for spending the
- 21. reserves fund has been set at the end of June; and,
- 22. WHEREAS, using the reserves fund for this event would not only deplete the
- 23. funds that must be used, but also give student fee dollars back to the students by



- 24. enhancing an established annual entertainment experience enjoyed by a wide
- 25. range of students on campus; and,
- 26. WHEREAS, contributing financially to Union Fest also allows for direct student
- 27. input in an event that is for the student body; and,
- 28. WHEREAS, initiating a plan to spend a portion of the reserves fund is a sign of
- 29. good faith to the Board of Trustees; and,
- 30. WHEREAS, the ASUW senate has been highly encouraging more student-
- 31. centric projects that have tangible impacts; and,
- 32. WHEREAS, if this bill passes, a member of the ASUW senate ought to attend
- 33. the 7220 student meetings during the Union Fest process.
- 34. THEREFORE, be it enacted that ASUW allocates \$100,000 from the ASUW
- 35. reserves fund to fund the music artist for Union Fest; anad,
- 36. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that ASUW requests representation in the
- 37. decision-making process of selecting the music artist for Union Fest; and,
- 38. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that ASUW will have a
- 39. liaison with 7220 Entertainment during the Union Fest process to provide
- 40. ASUW representation in 7220's meetings and to monitor the use of the reserve
- 41. funds; and,
- 42. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that a copy of this bill be sent to Alicia
- 43. Perez and Gwen Dailey; and,
- 44. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that this bill take effect immediately upon its
- 45. Passage.
