1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and
3. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Elections Policy has many discrepancies that need to be
4. fixed before the 112th Administration Elections are able to take place in order to allow
5. for the most efficient process possible; and,
6. WHEREAS, in Section 1.04 Subsection 7 Clause A Subclause a and Clause B Subclause
7. b it states that all students can vote at any polling place or online; and
8. WHEREAS, due to both the growth of technology and ease all polling has been done
9. remotely therefore getting rid of any physical polling place on campus making the work
10. “polling” be moot; and,
11. WHEREAS the ASUW Elections Policy should be changed as reflected in Addendum A.
12. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
13. Student Government that Section 1.04 Subsection 7 Clause A Subclause a and Clause B
14. Subclause b of the ASUW Elections Policy be amended as reflected in Addendum A; and
15. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that these changes are effective immediately.
