1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and
3. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Elections Policy has many discrepancies that need to be
4. fixed before the 112th Administration Elections are able to take place in order to allow
5. for the most efficient process possible; and,
6. WHEREAS, in Section 1.01 subsection 1 Clause C it requires the Homecoming,
7. Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee to put together two general
8. information sessions before applications close; and,
9. WHEREAS, due to precedent this had not occurred in a while and has been generally
10. replaced with having a prostaff member open to meeting with applicants to answer
11. questions; and,
12. WHEREAS, this section of the Election Policy should be changed as reflected in
13. Addendum A.
14. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
15. Student Government that Section 1.01 Subsection 1 Clause C of the ASUW Elections
16. Policy be changed as reflected in Addendum A; and
17. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that these changes are effective immediately.
