

- 1. WHEREAS the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming is to
- 2. serve the students in the best manner possible; and,
- 3. WHEREAS the Wyoming State Legislature introduced and approved the "Code of the
- 4. West" as an official code for the state of Wyoming in 2010, per WY State Legislation 8-
- 5. 3-123, as derived from the book, Cowboy Ethics by James P. Owen; and
- 6. WHEREAS The University of Wyoming is the sole four-year post-secondary academic
- 7. institution in the Cowboy State, and as such the values of the Code of the West are in line
- 8. with the values and ethics expected of Students and members of ASUW; and
- 9. WHEREAS it would serve as good principle to bring ASUW's Code into line with the
- 10. State Code that was adopted in 2010; and
- 11. THEREFORE, be enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 12. (ASUW) Student Government that the ASUW Bylaws be amended as shown in
- 13. Addendum A and establish the "Code of the West" as an official code of the Associated
- 14. Students of the University of Wyoming, and treated as a policy that is upheld within the
- 15. code of ethics; and
- 16. THEREFORE, be it resolved that these changes take effect immediately upon this bill's
- 17. passage.

Addendum A

ASUW BYLAWS, Article 5, "Code of Ethics", Section 5.02 "Standards of Behavior"

1. As an elected and/or appointed representative of the Associated Students at the University of Wyoming Student Government (ASUW):
