- 1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, during senate meeting communications the ASUW rules and procedures
- 4. state that the "executive assistants go after the president"; and,
- 5. WHEREAS, these assistants are just the Chief of Staff (COS) and Chief of Legislative
- 6. Affairs (COLA); and,
- 7. WHEREAS, for clarification purposes this should be updated to show the COS and
- 8. COLA rather than the executive assistants; and,

WHEREAS, the Student Legal Services Intern also has important updates to share with
the body; and,

11. WHEREAS, getting a communications section would allow for these to be delivered

12. directly to the body similar to our other programs delivering their communications; and,

- 13. WHEREAS, this position is technically not an ex-officio so they cannot just be added to
- 14. the ex-officio communications list so they should get their own spot after the ex-officios
- 15. go as seen in Addendum A.
- 16. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
- 17. Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government that the ASUW Rules and Procedures be

18. updated to reflect the changes made in Addendum A; and,

19. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these changes take effect upon the passage of

20. this bill.
