Addendum A

Section 6.01 ASUW Legislative Process

- 1. Bills and resolutions may be submitted by any fee-paying student. All bills and resolutions must be sponsored by no less than two (2) Senators, two (2) ex-officio members of the ASUW Senate (who are not authors), or by an ASUW standing committee. Executives, Students-at-Large, ASUW Programs or Services, and Recognized Student Organizations may also sponsor legislation; these sponsorships, however, are unofficial and do not contribute to the sponsorships needed to steer a piece of legislation. Regardless of their fee- paying student status, members of the Judicial Council may not author or sponsor legislation due to their association. Pro Staff may not sponsor legislation in the interest of avoiding professional bias.
 - a. Senators, Ex-Officios, or Executives that sit on a sponsoring ASUW standing committee cannot be listed as an individual sponsor.
