7. for the 114<sup>th</sup> Administration of the ASUW, the changes ought to be made as reflected in
8. Addendum A.

## **Addendum A**

### **Section 1.01 ASUW Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee**

#### **1. Responsibilities and Authorities**

A. The Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee shall annually prescribe and disseminate to all official candidates the following:

a. All election related and-associated dates as determined by the Committee to fit the current academic calendar following the guidelines set forth in this article. Every effort shall be made to swear in the newly elected candidates on the first Monday in May, unless this date is not a business day, or in such cases where this date falls after the end of the Academic Year, or during finals week, in which case the Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee shall modify the date to conform as closely as possible to this ideal.

b. The Homecoming, Outreach, Programming, and Elections Committee will be allowed to determine the quantity of funds included in the candidate printing fund and they will determine the amount of money each candidate will be eligible for, as long as it is within the parameters of the budget

c. Any other information deemed relevant to elections by the same Committee.

B. Applications and financial expense report forms shall be made available to all University of Wyoming Fee Paying students that qualify under the election requirements by 9:00 a.m. on a school day selected by the Committee ~~before the end of the second month of the spring semester.~~ by the sixtieth (60) day after the spring semester begins.
