




**SENATE BILL #3097**

**TITLE:** Restructuring of Program Audits  
**DATE INTRODUCED:** 03/06/2026

**SPONSORS:** **First-Year Senator Martinez, Programs and Institutional Development Committee**

1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
3. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Program and Institutional Development (PID)
4. Committee is to advise and assist all ASUW programs and services; and,
5. WHEREAS, PID shall also be responsible for ensuring that ASUW is constantly
6. developing into a more effective organization through restructuring of internal processes;
7. and,
8. WHEREAS, to ensure that all ASUW programs are running at their upmost capacity and
9. efficacy, PID should review all programs in a similar process to the codified First-Year
10. Senate process, as reflected in the changes in Addendum A.
11. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
12. Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government adopt the changes reflected in Addendum A;
13. and,
14. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that this bill go into effect immediately upon its
15. passage.

## Addendum A

### ASUW By-Laws, Article 2 Legislative Branch, Section 2.02 The ASUW Senate, Subsection

#### 10 Standing Committees

##### 4. The ASUW Program and Institutional Development Committee

- a. Purpose: The Program and Institutional Development Committee shall serve as a means by which the ASUW Senate shall advise and assist with all ASUW programs, **services, and committees.** ~~and services.~~ Furthermore, the committee shall be responsible for ensuring that the ASUW is constantly developing into a more effective organization through restructuring internal processes.
- b. Powers: The Committee shall advise and assist all ~~ASUW Programs and Services~~ **programs, services, and committees** of the ASUW and shall formally and evaluate aspects of the each and provide recommendations on how they can best fulfill their mission and goals. The Committee will maintain regular contact with all **programs, services, and committees** ~~Programs and Services~~ of the ASUW and will regularly provide institutional and programmatic support to each. The Committee will be tasked with electing an ex-officio for the Student Athlete Advisory Committee. The Committee will be responsible for submitting yearly reports to the Budget and Planning Committee pertaining to the effectiveness and need for funding in specific areas for each ASUW program. Additionally, the Committee shall be responsible for the formulation and execution of long-term policies and goals for the ASUW Student Government and its Programs and Services. To this end, it shall conduct an annual review of the current ASUW Strategic Plan within the first two months of the fall semester. With the ASUW President and ASUW Assistant Director also assisting. If necessary, this report shall contain recommended changes to the Strategic Plan to ensure its continued relevance, which can be passed through the legislative process. The committee shall be responsible for creating institutional restructuring when appropriate to improve ASUW processes. PID shall have the authority to request any information it deems necessary of other ASUW Committees and entities, and it shall use this information to determine areas that require additional focus. Subsequently, the Committee will be responsible for formulating action plans to address these areas of concern. The Committee will have the power to pass or veto program legislation in a manner determined by the chair. The Committee shall be vested with all necessary and appropriate powers to carry out its purpose under these rules.
- c. Program Audits Reviews: The Committee shall be tasked with conducting an annual, formal **audit** review of ~~the First-Year Senate~~ all ASUW **programs, including, but not limited to, First-Year Senate, Non-Traditional Student Council, and Graduate Student Council.** ~~Other programs may be audited at the discretion of the Committee.~~
  - i. If a program does not have any membership, is experiencing a major transition/restructuring period, or is newly created, they may not be subject to a review, at the discretion of the Committee.

- ii. To this extent, the chair and two members of the Committee shall attend two First-Year Senate meetings in the fall semester after program orientation. The chair and two members of the Committee shall attend one First-Year Senate meeting in the spring semester before spring break and one First-Year Senate meeting in the spring semester after spring break.
  - iii. The Committee shall check in with other programs and their leadership. The Chair and members of the Committee are encouraged to attend program meetings in the Fall and Spring Semesters to best evaluate the efficacy of the program and where the Committee and ASUW can provide support.
  - ~~iv. The audit shall be presented in a survey format with the questions to be at the discretion of the committee. General questions must include rating the efficacy of the Program, its committees, and its leadership. This survey will be given to the First Year Senate in the first spring meeting.~~
  - v. The review shall be presented in a survey format with the questions to be at the discretion of the Committee. General questions must include rating the efficacy of the Program, its committees, leadership, areas for improvement, and interaction with ASUW. This survey shall be created before the end of the fall semester and circulated to programs in the first week of the spring semester.
  - vi. The ~~audit~~ review shall be presented to the ~~First Year Senate at the second spring meeting.~~ programs and their leadership, after the review is completed by the Committee and a report has been compiled. Following the review of the First-Year Senate, the Chair shall meet with the First-Year Senate Advisor and the Vice President to discuss the results and potential areas of improvement for the First-Year Senate. Any changes to the procedure of this review process must be reflected in the First-Year Senate Rules and Procedures.
  - vii. The full report shall be provided to the Budget and Planning Committee before budget deliberations to aid in discussion regarding program funding.
  - ~~viii. Following the audit, the Chair shall meet with the First Year Senate Advisor and the Vice President to discuss the results and potential areas of improvement for the Program. Any changes to the procedure of this audit process must be reflected in the First Year Senate Rules and Procedures.~~
- d. Composition: The Committee shall consist of a minimum of six Senators of the ASUW, one (1) of whom shall serve as chairperson, one (1) being a First-Year Senator after their committee assignments, and a unique student representative of each ASUW program or service shall have the opportunity to serve as a voting member. The committee shall also elect a secretary, who will take attendance and take notes for the chair. All these program and service representatives are subject to the final approval of the ASUW Vice President. All program and service representatives will have the right to vote in this Committee. The ASUW Vice President shall appoint at least one (1) Executive to serve as an ex-officio on the committee.
