- 1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Elections Policy is in need of revision before the
- 4. elections of the 13th Administration take place to allow for the most efficient process
- 5. possible; and,
- 6. WHEREAS, there is a need for revision to the grade point average (GPA) requirements
- 7. outlined in Section 1.02 Subsections 1 and 2 Clause (A), outlined in Addendum A; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, this amendment should properly accommodate for GPA requirements from
- 9. programs that utilize different GPA requirements.
- 10. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 11. (ASUW) adopt the changes outlined in this bill; and,
- 12. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that this bill go into effect immediately upon its
- 13. passage.

Addendum A

Section 1.05 Candidate Requirements

Subsection 1 Clause A

b. They must have and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average as an undergraduate and a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average as a graduate or professional student or a 2.0 if the program does not require it-the minimum GPA which is required for their associated college program.
