- 1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) Freshman Senate to effectively serve the interests of the Freshman Class; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, a vast majority of the Freshman Class lives as on-campus residents; and,
- 4. WHEREAS, the Residence Hall Association (RHA) is the official governing body of
- 5. on-campus housing and enacts legislation, creates programs, and offers leadership
- 6. opportunities for these on-campus Freshman; and,
- 7. WHEREAS, specific Freshman interests might not be properly represented at RHA
- 8. meetings; and
- 9. WHEREAS, this form of communication between the ASUW Freshman Senate and RHA
- 10. would be beneficial to both parties; and,
- 11. WHEREAS, the fifth member of the steering committee currently has limited
- 12. Responsibilities.
- 13. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 14. (ASUW) Freshman Senate that, Article IV, Section 4 of The Constitution of the ASUW
- 15. Freshman Senate be amended to reflect the changes in Addendum A; and,
- 16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the ASUW Freshman Senate that, Article VI,
- 17. Section 2 of The Constitution of the ASUW Freshman Senate be amended to reflect the

Addendum A THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ASUW FRESHMAN SENATE ARTICLE IV

Appointed or Selected Officers

Section 4. Senate Officers

- A. At the first business meeting following the installation of Freshman Senate, the following officers are selected from the Freshman Senate voting membership:
 - Presiding Officer: He/she shall serve as the chairman of the Freshman Senate. He/she may not participate in debate unless he/she first relinquishes the chair to the Parliamentarian. He/she shall only vote in the case of a tie. He/she shall represent the Freshman Senate as an ex-officio member at the ASUW Senate weekly meetings. He/she shall serve as the chairman of the Steering Committee of the Freshman Senate.
 - 2. Parliamentarian: He/she shall keep the Freshman Senate in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order. He/she shall preserve order as the Presiding Officer may direct. He/she shall assume the duties of the Presiding Office in the absence of the Presiding Officer. He/she shall serve on the Steering Committee of the Freshman Senate.
 - 3. Secretary: He/she shall keep and distribute all minutes, an active roster, and votes in a time efficient manner. He/she shall prepare and circulate all weekly agendas and send all official Freshman Senate communications. He/she shall periodically write and circulate press releases on the happenings of Freshman Senate. He/she shall assume the duties of the Parliamentarian in the absence of the Parliamentarian. He/she shall serve on the Steering Committee of the Freshman Senate.
 - 4. Treasurer: He/she shall maintain the Freshman Senate budget and draft budget proposals each spring semester. He/she shall assume the duties of the Secretary in the absence of the Secretary. He/she shall serve on the Steering Committee of the Freshman Senate.
 - 5. Fifth Member of the Steering Committee: He/she shall serve as an ex-officio/liaison of the Freshman Senate at the Residence Hall Association (RHA) weekly meetings in accordance with their constitution and by-laws. He/she shall also serve on the Steering Committee of the Freshman Senate.
