

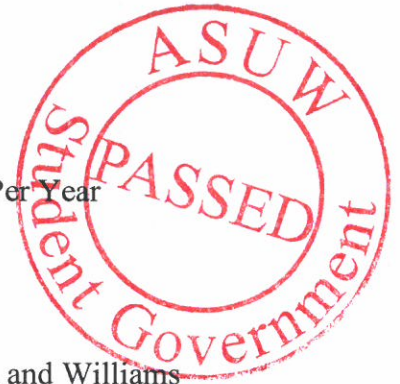
Freshman Senate Resolution #37

1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Freshman Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming to best represent the ideas and feelings of the freshman class;

4. WHEREAS, the Freshman Senate has an obligation to write legislation in the best
5. interests of the students each year; and,
6. WHEREAS, each new class of students at the University of Wyoming brings forth new
7. ideas, and has new concerns about the University community; and,
8. WHEREAS, in the past, Freshman Senate in certain years has not incorporated enough
9. legislation to best address the changes occurring at the University, and more specifically
10. for the freshman class; and,
11. WHEREAS, current senators feel an increase in legislation and programs would greatly
12. benefit each freshman class.
13. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Freshman Senate of the Associated Students of the
14. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that a minimum of three pieces of legislation per
15. semester are written to be brought forth before the Freshman Senate; and,
16. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Freshman Senate plan a minimum of two
17. programs per semester, budget permitting, for the University of Wyoming, or
18. specifically the freshman class.
