

**FRESHMAN SENATE BILL #40**

**TITLE:** Revision of Freshman Senator Responsibilities

1 WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)

2 Student Government to accurately represent our fellow students and ensure future student

3 representation through positive outreach and work efforts by Freshman Senators; and,

4 WHEREAS, upon taking the oath of office, Freshman Senators agree to fulfill obligations which

5 ensure the accurate representation of the student body through ASUW Student Government; and,

6 WHEREAS, the senators of the ASUW Student Government are required by the ASUW By-

7 Laws (Article II, Section 4, Subsection K, Subsection iv) to perform four service hours each full

8 month of the semester to be approved by the ASUW Vice President and the Steering Committee;

9 and,

10 WHEREAS, the current obligations of senators of the ASUW Student Government Freshman

11 Senate, as outlined by the ASUW Freshman Senate Constitution, do not currently address service

12 hours for Freshman Senators; and,

13 WHEREAS, the aforementioned obligation for each ASUW Freshman Senator to perform

14 service hours is in order to increase the effectiveness of the ASUW Freshman Senate.

15 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)

16 Student Government Freshman Senate that the ASUW Freshman Senate Constitution (Article

17 IV, Section 3) be amended to reflect the language in Addendum A.



## Addendum A

### Article IV

#### Section 3. Senator Obligations:

D. ASUW senators shall have the following standardized physical responsibilities:

1. Each full month of the academic semester, senators will be required to accumulate one (1) service hours. The Service hours can be accumulated through the following means:
  - a. Documented office hour in the ASUW office.
  - b. Documented participation in an ASUW student outreach event.
  - c. Documented attendance or participation in an ASUW funded event.
  - d. Documented volunteering with an ASUW program.
2. Appropriate documentation and documentation methods of service hours will be set and managed by the Freshman Senate Steering Committee.
3. Senators shall attend a minimum of two (2) events funded by ASUW per semester, and complete a review to be submitted to the Freshman Senate Programming Committee and the ASUW RSO Funding Board for each event.
