

## **SENATE RESOLUTION #1**

**Title: Freshman Live-In Policy Revisions**

**Date: November 8, 1995**

**Authors: Freshman Living Committee**

**Sponsors: Senators Schwietert, Sherlock, and Evenson**

1. WHEREAS, it is beneficial to have a policy that requires freshmen at the
2. University of Wyoming to live in Campus housing; and
3. WHEREAS, in the current Freshman Live-In Proposal, the students of
4. Freshman Senate do not agree with the exit requirements as currently proposed;
5. and,
6. WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the Freshman Senate that students need to be able
7. to go before a committee to express their concern when dealing with extenuating
8. circumstances; and,
9. WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the Freshman Senate that a provision be added to
10. proposal that includes an exit requirement for those individuals who wish to join
11. the Greek houses on campus; and,
12. WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the Freshman Senate that the credit hour standard
13. which is currently set at 30 or more credits, be amended to two full terms of
14. living in the residence halls.
15. THEREFORE, it is the feeling of the Freshman Senate at the University of
16. Wyoming that certain criteria be amended to the Freshman Live-In Proposal.
17. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that new sections be added to the Freshman
18. Live-In Proposal that include:

19. 1) Amending the proposal that changes the current requirement of 30  
20. or more credit hours, to a total of two full terms of living in the  
21. residence halls; and
22. 2) A committee that addresses freshman students with reasons for  
23. individual exemptions and the committee shall include but not be  
24. restricted to representatives from RHA, Freshman Senate, ASUW,  
25. Student Affairs; and
26. 3) Include a clause for freshman students moving into the Greek  
27. housing on campus.
