TITLE: Revision of the Duties of the Procedures Committee

1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
2. Student Government Freshman Senate to accurately represent our fellow students and ensure
3. future student representation through positive outreach; and,
4. WHEREAS, under the Freshman Senate Constitution (Article V, Section 2, Subsection B,
5. Clause 3) it is the duty of the Procedures Committee to review all legislative actions affecting
6. the Freshman Senate Constitution or any ASUW bills and resolutions affecting the ASUW
7. Constitution, By-Laws, Rules and Procedures, and all working documents and;
8. WHEREAS, a substantial amount of legislation which affect the Freshman Senate
9. Constitution is introduced; and,
10. WHEREAS, the current duties of the Freshman Senate Advisor include updating the ASUW
11. Freshman Senate Constitution as often as passed legislation mandates; and,
12. WHEREAS, the shift of responsibility of updating the ASUW Freshman Senate Constitution
13. from the Freshman Senate Advisor to the Procedures Committee is appropriate in accordance
14. to the language of Article V, Section 2, Subsection B, Clause 3 of the Freshman Senate
15. Constitution.
16. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
17. (ASUW) Student Government Freshman Senate that the ASUW Freshman Senate
18. Constitution (Article V, Section 2, Subsection B) be amended to reflect the language outlined

19. in Addendum A; and,

20. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that this bill be effective upon passage.

Addendum A

ARTICLE V Committees

Section 2. Standing Committees

B. Procedures Committee

1. A minimum of five (5) Freshman Senators will serve as the membership for the Procedures Committee.
2. The Procedures Committee will internally select a chairman.
3. The Procedures Committee will review all legislative actions affecting the Freshman Senate Constitution or any ASUW bills and resolutions regarding the ASUW Constitution, By-Laws, Rules and Procedures, and all working documents. The Procedures Committee will handle any vacancies in the Freshman Senate outside of the standard election. The Procedures Committee will also review any legislative action from the Freshman Senate or from the ASUW, as directed by the Steering Committee.
4. The Procedures Committee shall have the power to ensure that all adopted amendments to the Freshman Senate Constitution are updated. The committee shall do so at the subsequent meeting after the amendment(s) have been signed into action. ~~The Programming Committee will review any legislative action from the Freshman Senate or from the ASUW, as directed all Senate retreats and other internal activities, researching and rejuvenating lost campus traditions, and for planning all socia~~
