Addendum A

ARTICLE III

Membership

Section 1.

Any full time, first-year student enrolled in the University of Wyoming shall be a member of the Freshman Senate during each regular semester of that year.

a. A full time, first-year student shall be a student with no more than 30 transfer credits at the start of the fall term of their enrollment, and no more than 12 credits from the University of Wyoming.
