- 1. WHEREAS, it is the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming

- 4. WHEREAS, smoking and inhalation of tobacco has been proven hazardous to health; and,
- 5. WHEREAS, the exposure to secondhand smoke is a cause of disease and health concerns in
- 6. non-smoking individuals; and,
- 7. WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states that secondhand smoke
- 8. contains more than 7,000 chemicals, hunderds of which are toxic, and approximately 70 that
- 9. can cause cancer; and,
- 10. WHEREAS, University of Wyoming students have expressed concerns about smoking on
- 11. campus; and,
- 12. WHEREAS, there are 1,475 smoke-free campuses in the United Sates as of January 1, 2016;
- 13. and,
- 14. WHEREAS, exposure to smoking on campus may directly impact the educational
- 15. endeavors and well-being of University of Wyoming students.
- 16. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 17. (ASUW) Student Government Freshman Senate that the ASUW fully support the amendment

Addendum A

I. POLICY

UW REGULATION 2-180 Regulating Smoking

It is the policy of the University of Wyoming main campus to ensure that all of its facilities including public places and places of employment are smoke free.

II. DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this Regulation, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1. "University" means the University of Wyoming;
- 2. "Smoke or smoking" means the act of burning any tobacco product, weed filler or plant of any kind in a cigarette, cigar, pipe, water pipe, or in any other device;
- 3. "Smoking instrument" means any cigarette, cigar, pipe or other smoking device;
- 4. "Public places" means enclosed the campus and facilities of the University of Wyoming facilities, all seating and general gathering areas where outdoor programs, events and activities are held and reasonable distances from all entranceways, passageways, operable windows or ventilation systems of any enclosed facility and inside any licensed vehicle owned by the University.

III. DIRECTIVE

- 1. No University student or employee, or member of the general public shall smoke or
 - carry any lighted smoking instrument in any public place of the University.
- Any University student or employee, or member of the general public persisting in smoking contrary to the terms of this Regulation, after an oral or written request or warning to cease smoking, shall be deemed to be in violation of this Regulation.
- 3. Smoking is permitted in the following:
- (1.) Outdoor areas including University sidewalks, seating areas and grounds that are a reasonable distance from entranceways, passageways, operable windows or ventilation systems of public places.

IV . SANCTIONS

Any University student or employee, or member of the general public violating any provision of this Regulation may be required to forfeit the benefits of University programs, events or privileges pursuant to UW Regulations.
