

**FIRST-YEAR SENATE RESOLUTION #54**



**TITLE:** Articles of Impeachment – Kolbe Hoppa  
**DATE INTRODUCED:** February 12, 2019

**SPONSORS:** First-Year Senate Steering Committee

1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the ASUW First-Year Senate is to serve our fellow students in
2. the best manner possible through accurate representation, professional interaction with
3. campus programs and organizations, and responsible, effective leadership; and,
4. WHEREAS, the ASUW First-Year Senate Constitution clearly states, “The Steering
5. Committee shall have the power to bring impeachment charges should the Committee find
6. such action necessary and appropriate under the circumstances;” and,
7. WHEREAS, Senator Hoppa has been absent from the first two Senate meetings of the
8. 2019 Spring Semester, and has not attended the first two meetings of Student Outreach and
9. Programming committee (of which he is a member,) and;
10. WHEREAS, Senator Hoppa now has three (3) unexcused absences from the Spring ’19
11. Semester and has not provided any reasoning for his absence.
12. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the First-Year Senate of the Associated Students of the
13. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that charges of impeachment be brought against Senator
14. Hoppa.
