## Water Wise Plants

Jenny Jones (UW Cooperative Extension Service) will talk about the many different plants that can be used to create water wise landscapes in the Laramie area, saving you money, resources and creating a beautiful place to be.

## Planting Trees with Drip Irrigation

Matt Scott (Laramie Rivers Conservation District) will demonstrate proper tree planting techniques and how to set up a drip irrigation system for people interested in setting up their own shelterbelts or low-water gardens.

## Practical Weed Control

Lindsey Cawthra (Albany County Weed & Pest) will demonstrate weed treatment techniques and talk about various treatment options.

## Building Green Outbuildings

Tim Nyquist (Laramie County Community College, Construction Technology) will talk about using earth friendly building materials and techniques, for outbuildings, etc. that can actually save money.

## Weed ID

Dr. Stephen Enloe (UW Cooperative Extension Service) will give a slide show and pass around live weeds you might encounter in Albany. Bring your unknown weeds and questions.

## Managing Your Pasture

Calvin Strom (UW Cooperative Extension Service) and Martin Curry (LRCD) will take you through an exercise to estimate grass production in a pasture in order to understand how much grazing can be sustained. They will also talking about creating paddocks and a plan for rotational grazing.
