

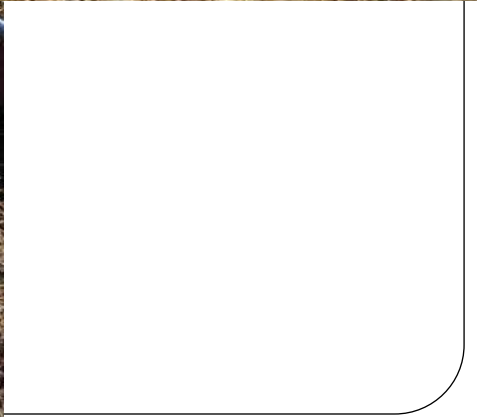


Broad Fork

Cardboard/Newspaper





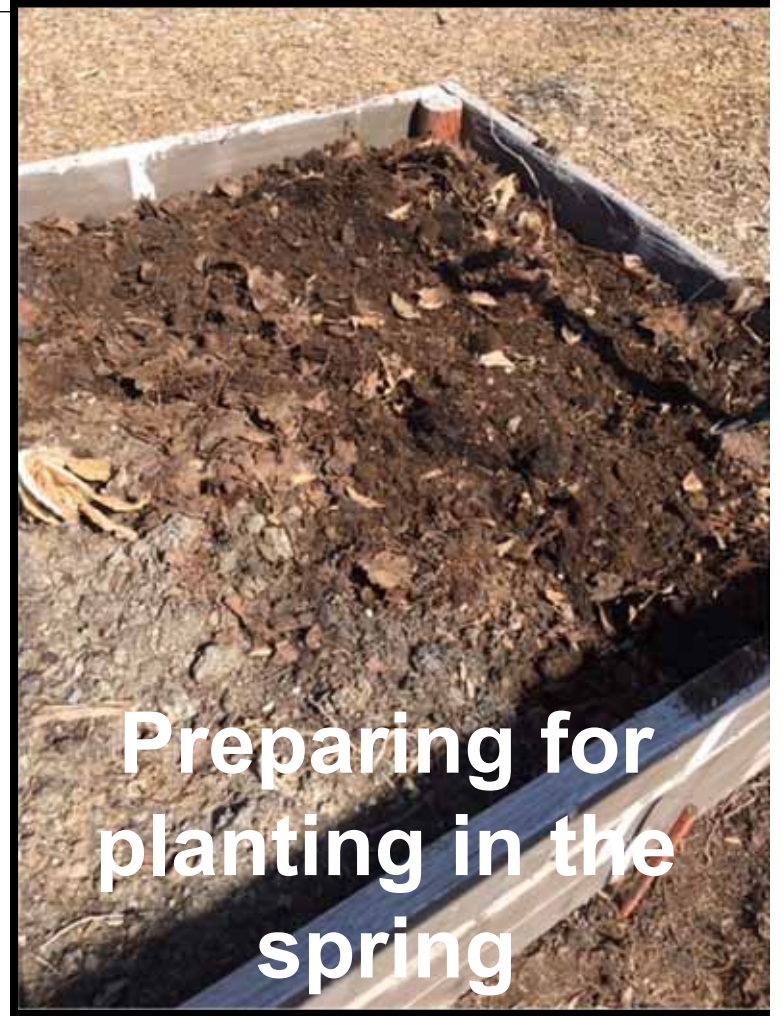
