INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON COMPLIANCE AND ON INTERNAL CONTROL OVER FINANCIAL REPORTING BASED ON AN AUDIT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT AUDITING STANDARDS

To the Board of Trustees University of Wyoming Laramie, Wyoming

We have audited the financial statements of the University of Wyoming as of and for the year ended June 30, 2001 and have issued our report thereon dated September 21, 2001. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

Compliance

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the University's financial statements are free of material misstatement, we performed tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts and grants, noncompliance with which could have a direct and material effect on the determination of financial statement amounts. However, providing an opinion on compliance with those provisions was not an objective of our audit and, accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. The results of our tests disclosed no instances of noncompliance that are required to be reported under *Government Auditing Standards*.

Internal Control over Financial Reporting

In planning and performing our audit, we considered the University's internal control over financial reporting in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements and not to provide assurance on the internal control over financial reporting. Our consideration of the internal control over financial reporting would not necessarily disclose all matters in the internal control over financial reporting that might be material weaknesses. A material weakness is a condition in which the design or operation of one or more of the internal control components does not reduce to a relatively low level the risk that misstatements in amounts that would be material in relation to the financial statements being audited may occur and not be detected within a timely period by employees in the normal course of performing their assigned functions. We noted no matters involving the internal control over financial reporting and its operation that we consider to be material weaknesses.

We did, however, note matters involving the internal control structure and its operation that we have reported to the management of the University in a separate letter dated September 21, 2001.

This report is intended for the information of the Board of Trustees, management, Federal awarding agencies and pass-through entities and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than those specified parties.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO EACH MAJOR PROGRAM AND INTERNAL CONTROL OVER COMPLIANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH OMB CIRCULAR A-133

To the Board of Trustees University of Wyoming Laramie, Wyoming

Compliance

We have audited the compliance of the University of Wyoming with the types of compliance requirements described in the *U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement* that are applicable to each of its major Federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2001. The University's major Federal programs are identified in the summary of auditor's results section of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs. Compliance with the requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants applicable to each of its major Federal programs is the responsibility of the University's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the University's compliance based on our audit.

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America; the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States; and OMB Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments and Non-Profit Organizations*. Those standards and OMB Circular A-133 require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether noncompliance with the types of compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on a major Federal program occurred. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence about the University's compliance with those requirements and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our audit does not provide a legal determination on the University's compliance with those requirements.

In our opinion, the University complied, in all material respects, with the requirements referred to above that are applicable to each of its major Federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2001. However, the results of our auditing procedures disclosed instances of noncompliance with those requirements that are required to be reported in accordance with OMB Circular A-133 and which are described in Section III.A. of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as items 01-4 through 01-8.

Internal Control over Compliance

The management of the University is responsible for establishing and maintaining effective internal control over compliance with requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants applicable to Federal programs. In planning and performing our audit, we considered the University's internal control over compliance with requirements that could have a direct and material effect on a major Federal program in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on compliance and to test and report on internal control over compliance in accordance with OMB Circular A-133.

We noted certain matters involving the internal control over compliance and its operation that we consider to be a reportable conditions. Reportable conditions involve matters coming to our attention relating to significant deficiencies in the design or operation of the internal control over compliance that, in our judgment, could adversely affect the University's ability to administer a major Federal program in accordance with applicable requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants. The reportable conditions are described in Section III.A. of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as item 01-1 through 01-3.

A material weakness is a condition in which the design or operation of one or more of the internal control components does not reduce to a relatively low level the risk that noncompliance with applicable requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants that would be material in relation to a major Federal program being audited may occur and not be detected within a timely period by employees in the normal course of performing their assigned functions. Our consideration of the internal control over compliance would not necessarily disclose all matters in the internal control that might be reportable conditions and, accordingly, would not disclose all reportable conditions that are considered to be material weaknesses. However, we believe none of the reportable conditions described above are material weaknesses.

Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards

We have audited the financial statements of the University of Wyoming as of and for the year ended June 30, 2001, and have issued our report thereon dated September 21, 2001. Our audit was performed for the purpose of forming an opinion on the basic financial statements taken as a whole. The accompanying schedule of expenditures of Federal awards is presented for purposes of additional analysis as required by OMB Circular A-133 and is not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the basic financial statements and, in our opinion, is fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the basic financial statements taken as a whole.

This report is intended for the information of the Board of Trustees, management, Federal awarding agencies and pass-through entities and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than those specified parties.

NOTES TO SCHEDULE OF EXPENDITURES OF FEDERAL AWARDS

Note 1. Basis of Presentation

The purpose of the schedule of expenditures of Federal awards (the "Schedule") is to present a summary of the activities of the University of Wyoming (the "University") for the year ended June 30, 2001, which have been financed by the U.S. Government. The Schedule is presented on the cash basis of accounting. The information in this Schedule is presented in accordance with the requirements of OMB Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations*. Therefore, some amounts presented in this Schedule may differ from amounts presented in, or used in the preparation of the general purpose financial statements.

For purposes of the Schedule, Federal awards have been classified into two types:

- 1. Direct Federal awards consisting of Federal assistance and Federal student financial aid, and
- 2. Pass-through funds received from non-Federal organizations made under Federally sponsored programs conducted by those organizations.

Note 2. Student Loan Funds and Loans Outstanding

Student loans are funded by the Federal government under the Federal Perkins Loan Program. Activity related to this loan program in the accompanying Schedule includes capital transactions such as Federal and University contributions. This Schedule excludes certain transactions between students and outside third parties, including Federal Family Educational Loans, Parents Loans for Undergraduate Students and Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loans. Loans processed by the University and distributed by third parties were \$18,385,017 for Federal Family Educational Loans, \$1,011,733 for Parents Loans for Undergraduate Students, and \$3,849,263 for Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loans for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001.

The University's Federal Perkins Loan Program (CFDA 84.038) had an outstanding loan balance of \$6,484,691 as of June 30, 2001. Loans disbursed from the Federal Perkins Loan Program were \$1,040,724 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001. There are no Federal capital contributions for the year ended June 30, 2001.

III. FINDINGS AND QUESTIONED COSTS FOR FEDERAL AWARDS

A. Reportable Conditions

- 01-1: The University does not have an adequate system in place to monitor the cost-sharing/matching requirements for the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) grant awards administered by the College of Agriculture, including section 3(b), (c), and (d) of the Smith Lever awards. Expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements are required to be allowable under the provisions of the grant award. Currently, expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements are not reviewed for allowability under the grant award, and amounts may be used as cost sharing of other Federally sponsored projects. We recommend that the grants for the CES, including the section 3(b) and (c) awards, be placed into the same system for tracking cost sharing that is already in place at the University for all other Federally sponsored projects.
- **01-2:** The University does not have an adequate system in place to monitor the period of availability for the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) grant awards. The University transfers remaining unspent amounts into future award budgets in PISTOL. As such, it reports those funds as being spent, when, in fact, they have not been spent. We recommend that the CES leave all unspent amounts in their original budget/project number in order to track the proper expenses for the proper grant award.
- **01-3:** The University's Cooperative Extension Service (CES) transfers amounts from Federal projects to departments to compensate those departments for salaries and other items that the department provides to the program. When these transfers occur, no documentation of the compensation and support is provided to justify the amount of services provided, or that such services were allowable. We recommend that the CES obtain documentation from the department that supports the transferred amount. The CES is also reporting these transfers as expenditures on its SF-269 reports, when the expenditure has not actually occurred.

B. Compliance

01-4: Student Financial Aid – Return of Title IV Funds

Condition: Of the 23 returns of Title IV funds tested from a population of 118, seven were calculated incorrectly, resulting in students returning amounts to the U.S. Department of Education, which should have been returned by the University.

Criteria: All return of Title IV Funds calculations are to be done using the method specified by the Federal Government. This calculation includes an amount of institutional charges, which includes tuition, fees, as well as room and board, if those charges are from the University. All amounts are required to be returned to the Department of Education, in appropriate amounts from the school and the student.

Cause: Due to implementation of new Federal regulations beginning in Fall 2000, and turnovers in Financial Aid Office personnel, the returns of Title IV funds were not calculated using the correct amount of institutional charges.

Effect: A violation or failure to comply with Federal laws and regulations may result in the Federal agency withholding payments to the University, withholding approval of further grants with the University, and any other action deemed necessary to gain compliance.

Recommendation: The University should include all of the appropriate institutional charges in the calculation of the returns of Title IV funds.

Questioned Costs: \$1,797

01-5: Research and Development and Teacher Quality Enhancement - Procurement

Condition: Ninety-two expenditures were selected to determine if procurement standards apply. Of those, it was determined that five required procurement procedures to be applied. Of the five tested, two purchases did not contain proper documentation of the bidding process or justification for not using the bidding process.

Criteria: According to the University's purchasing manual, all expenditures for purchases of supplies, materials, equipment and services in excess of \$7,500 must be purchased by means of a competitive, sealed bid. When competitive bidding is not feasible, justification for not bidding must be documented. The University's policies are in accordance with Federal guidelines.

Cause: The University was unable to locate the documentation for one purchase of equipment, as it was misplaced. For the purchase of consulting services, the University does not use the procurement process set forth in the University's purchasing policy.

Effect: A violation or failure to comply with Federal laws and regulations may result in the Federal agency withholding payments to the University, withholding approval of further grants with the University, and any other action deemed necessary to gain compliance.

SCHEDULE OF FINDINGS AND QUESTIONED COSTS Year Ended June 30, 2001

Recommendation: We recommend that the University maintain appropriate documentation for each purchase in excess of \$7,500. We also recommend that the University's policy to use procurement for the purchase of services be used when obtaining consulting services, or amend their purchasing policy to specifically exclude consulting services.

Questioned Costs: \$22,685

01-6: Research and Development – Financial Reporting

Condition: Of 23 research and development projects selected for testing, three quarterly financial reports were not filed by the deadline specified in the grant agreement, one annual financial report was not filed, and three annual performance reports were not filed.

Criteria: Recipients of Federal funds shall submit financial and performance reports as required by the Federal or pass-through entity per the A-133 Compliance Supplement.

Cause: The University staff overlooked or was unaware of the reporting requirements for these grants.

Effect: A violation or failure to comply with Federal laws and regulations may result in the Federal agency withholding payments to the University, withholding approval of further grants with the University, and any other action deemed necessary to gain compliance.

Recommendation: The Contracts and Grants Office should review grant requirements periodically to ensure that the required reports have been submitted by the deadline and all reporting requirements have been met. In regards to performance reports, the Contracts and Grants Office should be more strict in its requirement that principal investigators send copies of the performance reports to the Contracts and Grants Office to be retained in the grant file.

Questioned Costs: \$0

01-7: Student Financial Aid – Returns of Title IV Funds

Condition: Of the 23 calculations of returns of Title IV Funds, one of those refunds resulted in a potential post-withdrawal disbursement. It was noted that the post-withdrawal disbursement tested did not have the required notification sent to the student.

Criteria: When the calculation of a refund results in a potential post-withdrawal disbursement, the institution must offer any amount of post-withdrawal disbursement, that is not credited to the student's account, to the student or parent, within 30 days of the withdrawal date. 34 CFR 668.22 indicates this communication must be in writing.

Cause: The University staff was unaware of this requirement.

SCHEDULE OF FINDINGS AND QUESTIONED COSTS Year Ended June 30, 2001

Effect: A violation or failure to comply with Federal laws and regulations may result in the Federal agency withholding payments to the University, withholding approval of further grants with the University, and any other action deemed necessary to gain compliance.

Recommendation: The University should institute, as part of its return of Title IV Funds policy, a policy that includes the sending of appropriate letters to students when the return of funds calculation results in a potential post-withdrawal disbursement.

Questioned Costs: \$0

01-8: Cooperative Extension Service – Financial Reporting

Condition: Six out of nine financial reports selected for testing had incorrect expenditure or cost-sharing amounts reported.

Criteria: Recipients of Federal funds shall submit financial reports, as required by the Federal entity, which should reflect the financial records of the University.

Cause: The College of Agriculture Business Office did not prepare the reports correctly. Expenditure amounts did not agree to the general ledger. Cost-sharing amounts reported were budgeted amounts, and not actual expenditures.

Effect: A violation or failure to comply with Federal laws and regulations may result in the Federal agency withholding payments to the University, withholding approval of further grants with the University, and any other action deemed necessary to gain compliance.

Recommendation: Reports should be prepared using the actual expenditure amounts, as recorded in the University's general ledger. Cost-sharing amounts need to be tracked and actual expenditures reported on those reports.

Questioned Costs: \$0

SUMMARY SCHEDULE OF PRIOR AUDIT FINDINGS Year Ended June 30, 2001

FINDING

STATUS

00-1: The University did not have an adequate system in place to monitor the cost-sharing/matching requirements for the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) grant awards. Expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements are required to be allowable under provisions of the grant award. Expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements were not reviewed for allowability under the grant award.

As of June 30, 2001, none of the cost-sharing requirements on the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) awards are being tracked on the University's cost-sharing system. CES is in the process of setting up the awards in the system subsequent to June 30, 2001. See Finding 01-1, which indicates that the condition still exists at June 30, 2001.

00-2: Four financial reports were not filed by the deadline specified in the grant award or by the awarding agency.

Grant awards are reviewed monthly for Federal reporting requirements. However, as noted in Finding 01-6, seven reports selected for testing were not filed by the specified deadline, or were not filed at all during the year ended June 30, 2001.

00-3: Ten Cooperative Extension Service reports selected for testing were prepared using the wrong month's financial information.

The Cooperative Extension Service Reports were prepared using a report dated for the appropriate month, which was produced from the University's general ledger. However, as noted in Finding 01-8, the expenditure amounts reported do not agree to the University's general ledger.

00-4: There were approximately 340 outstanding Perkins loans for which due diligence procedures had not been fully performed. Many of these loans had been turned over to collection agencies; however, those agencies did not follow appropriate Federal requirements and did not return the loans to the University at the required time. Requests for the return of the files were not answered or were refused by the agencies. These loans entered into default status prior to May 15, 1990.

The University obtained expert legal counsel to serve as a liaison to the Department of Education. Counsel and University administration proposed a resolution and the Department has taken the matter under advisement. Additional information has been provided as requested by the Department, however, no decision has been made as of June 30, 2001. The University will continue to pursue resolution of this matter with the Department.

Reportable Conditions

01-1: Cooperative Extension Service

The University does not have an adequate system in place to monitor the cost-sharing/matching requirements for the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) grant awards administered by the College of Agriculture, including section 3(b), (c), and (d) of the Smith Lever awards. Expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements are required to be allowable under the provisions of the grant award. Currently, expenditures used to meet cost-sharing requirements are not reviewed for allowability under the grant award, and amounts may be used as cost sharing of other Federally sponsored projects. We recommend that the grants for the CES, including the section 3(b) and (c) awards, be placed into the same system for tracking cost sharing that is already in place at the University for all other Federally sponsored projects.

Completion date – September 30, 2001

Action Plan – Cost share for all Smith Lever awards requiring match will be shown on the PARs beginning with the federal fiscal year 2002 and recorded through the cost-share tracking system in the Contracts and Grants office. Cost share for all 3(b) and (c) formula funds will be charged to the general Smith/Lever administrative account on PISTOL.

01-2: Cooperative Extension Service

The University does not have an adequate system in place to monitor the period of availability for the Cooperative Extension Service (CES) grant awards. The University transfers remaining unspent amounts into future award budgets in PISTOL. As such, it reports those funds as being spent, when, in fact, they have not been spent. We recommend that the CES leave all unspent amounts in their original budget/project number in order to track the proper expenses for the proper grant award.

The CES is also reporting these transfers as expenditures on its SF-269 reports, when the expenditure has not actually occurred.

Corrective Action Plan

Completion date – September 30, 2001

Action Plan – Support to the departments will be given in state funds when possible beginning with the university fiscal year 2003. When federal funds are given as support, documentation will be provided to justify the amount of service provided and copies of the detail transactions kept by the department will be obtained and archived at the time the SF-269 reports are completed. The department will receive initial instructions and periodic monitoring to assure federal funds are being utilized for approved expenditures. Actual expenditures will be reported and verified with PISTOL reports.

The date of either will be indicated on the Requisition. The Buyers will keep bid documentation and all justification letters. In addition, the Purchasing Policy has been amended to exclude consulting services from the bid process.
