The online Business Administration (BSAD) degree is a completion-program designed to provide a foundation in all business disciplines to prepare you for a wide variety of careers. Once you have successfully completed general education and prerequisite business course work through a community college or other institution, the program allows you to finish the remainder of the degree online through the University of Wyoming (UW). Therefore, the online BSAD degree requires students to have completed Advanced Business Standing (ABS), before completing upper division course work from UW.

The University of Wyoming online Business Administration degree is designed for the student to finish the remainder of the Business Administration degree online and, therefore, is a completion-program. After completing UW approved general education courses and Business Administration prerequisites at a community college or other university, students are eligible to apply for admission into the online undergraduate Business Administration degree program.

All students transferring to the College of Business will be required to apply and be fully admitted to the University of Wyoming, have a 2.50 cumulative grade point average, and have Advanced Business Standing (ABS) completed before being considered for admission into the Business Administration online program.

This program has been formulated to meet the requirements of AACSB International (the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business), the University of Wyoming, and the College of Business.

## Minimum requirements include:

- Minimum of 42 semester hours of 3000+ level courses. 30 of the 42 hours must be earned from UW.
- 2.50 grade point average in all College of Business courses and all institution (UW) courses.
- 50% of the business credit hours must be from the University of Wyoming.
- A maximum of 6 hours at the 1000/2000 level and 3000/4000 level military science may be applied to degrees in the College of Business.
- Grade of C (C- not acceptable) or above required for University Studies Program: FY, C1, C2, and C3.
- Grade of C (C- not acceptable) or <u>above</u> required for common body of knowledge and major specific core courses.
- Grade of C (C- not acceptable) or above in MGT 4800 and a passing score on the exit exam for COB majors.
