

*Melanoplus lakinus* is an uncommon grasshopper found in southeastern Wyoming. Localized populations can be found in weedy vacant lots in suburban areas or other disturbed areas. Adults were collected in late August during this survey. They feed exclusively on plants from the Chenopodiaceae family and are known to eat Russianthistle and lambsquarter. This species has no economic importance in Wyoming.
