

Pardalophora haldemanii is a large uncommon grasshopper that occurs in Wyoming's grasslands east of the Continental Divide. It prefers drier areas than *P. apiculata*. Nymphs overwinter in the third and fourth instar. Adults are present in late June and July. It is not considered a pest species in Wyoming.
