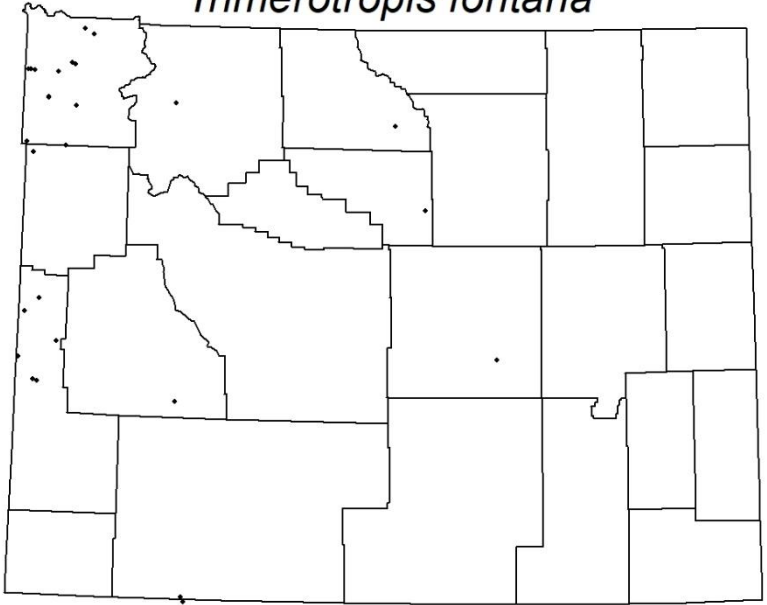


Trimerotropis fontana



Trimerotropis fontana occurs mainly west of Wyoming but some populations are found in the western half of the state. It prefers dry grasses and sagebrush in openings in pines. It is often found on patches of barren gravelly soil. Adults were collected in late August and September. This uncommon species has no known economic importance in Wyoming.
