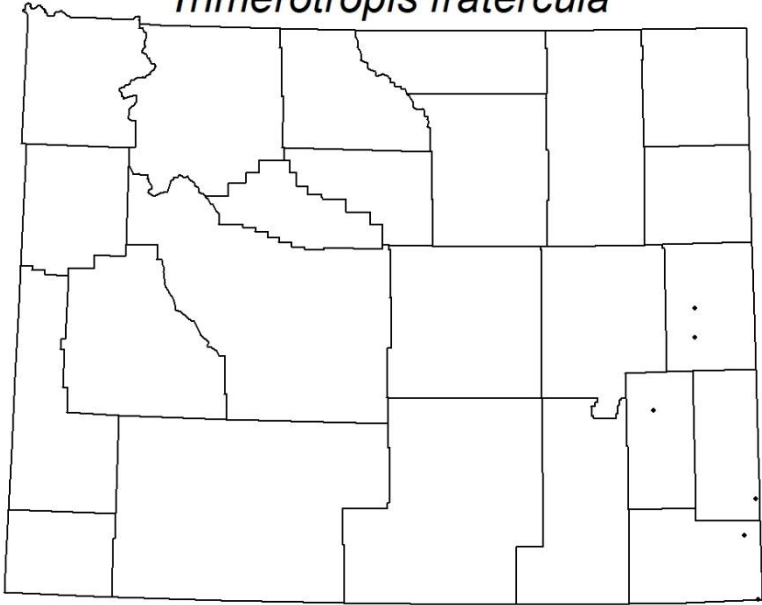


Trimerotropis fratercula



Trimerotropis fratercula has been found in eastern Wyoming as far north as Niobrara county. It prefers open pine savannahs and mountain foothills. Our adult specimens were collected between late July and early September. This uncommon grasshopper is not considered an economic pest in Wyoming.
