**412 Traps were examined:**

- 95 Traps were placed by WY USDA APHIS PPQ
- 160 Traps were placed by Wyoming State Forestry
- 137 Traps were placed by National Park Service
  - 0 Traps were placed by US Forest Service
- 20 Traps were placed by Wyoming Department of Agriculture
  - 0 Traps were placed by Joint State and Federal Agencies
