Total Program Credits: 120

- A minimum of 120 hours is required. A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division.
- Degree candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Grades of C or better are required for all courses used to satisfy program requirements.
- General Electives cannot meet any other requirement for the major, and should be selected to satisfy the 42-credit upper division requirement.
- Geography Content areas: 1. Physical Geography 2. Human Geography 3. Geographic Information Science 4. Interdisciplinary
- Geography Breadth: one course in 3 content areas.
- Geography Depth: Two courses in 2 content areas.
- Sophomore year: Students are encouraged to discuss study abroad opportunities with their advisor, mentor, and study abroad office.
