BuzzFile

What is BuzzFile?

BuzzFile is the most advanced company information database with advanced search and productivity tools that enable users to locate the exact businesses they are searching for. It also provides colleges and universities access to potential employers by major and state. It enables students to discover

thousands of potential employers in their major.

How to use BuzzFile Effectively?

To utilize BuzzFile most effectively use the following features that BuzzFile includes:

- Powerful organizational tools that allow users to see their research in a tabular format where they can select which columns of information to display. Furthermore, they can sort and filter by any field as well as highlight and map specific prospects.
- Personalize and save virtually everything. To maximize efficiency and reduce redundant effort, users are able to save their work. Users can create search criteria that yield the exact list of companies they are looking for. They can then name and save that criteria where it will be available for them to use in the future. Users are also able to save as many addresses as they want, allowing them to quickly find companies within a set distance from these addresses. Users can create and save custom views by selecting what columns of information to display. They can also name and save their search results as a LIST.
- The LIST functionality on Buzzfile is particularly powerful. A user can create, name, save and share lists. They have the flexibility to share these lists with other colleagues, everyone or no one at all. They can set it as a Public List where anyone can view or edit it. They can set it as a Members-Only List where the user determines who has access to the list and whether they can edit it or not. A Members-Only List will appear in search results but non-members will not be able to view its contents. They can also set the list as a Private List. Although Private Lists do not appear in search results, the user can still share them with others if they choose. Once a list is created, those who have edit privileges can add or remove companies from the list, constantly improving the quality and value of the list
- Highly functional Company Reports with a wealth of contextually relevant information. Buzzfile not only provides the typical contact, industry and map information but a great deal more. Users are able to see company and trade name, estimated revenues and employees, year business was formed, other businesses located at the same address, similar businesses nearby, nearby resources including restaurants, coffee shops, parking facilities, hotels, and neighborhood demographic information. Users also have the ability to download to contacts or add to lists.
