Thank you for your interest in our graduate programs.

We offer programs leading to Master of Science and Doctorate degrees in Civil Engineering. We currently have faculty with expertise in Architectural Engineering, structural engineering, geotechnical engineering, environmental engineering, transportation engineering and water resources engineering.

A Master of Science in Environmental Engineering is available in cooperation with the Department of Chemical and Petroleum Engineering. This interdisciplinary degree offers students an engineering perspective for solutions to unique environmental problems and is open to BS students in engineering, chemistry, and biological sciences.

The Department also offers an interdisciplinary degree in Water Resources. The core of this degree is in Civil Engineering with supporting coursework from the College of Agriculture.

Financial support for qualified graduate students is available mainly in the form of research and teaching assistantships. The University of Wyoming waives all tuition and fees for all graduate assistantships. All assistantships require course work and research activities that are usually coincident with the MS thesis or Ph.D. dissertation topic.

Admission is open to all students holding a bachelor's degree with at least a B average from an accredited engineering curriculum and having achieved a combined verbal and quantitative score of at least 900 on the GRE (1000 for Ph.D.) and a minimum score of 40% on the verbal portion of the GRE. International students must achieve a score of 550 on the paper-based TOEFL with a minimum of 58 on section I,a minimum TOEFL iBT of 76, or an IELTS minimum score of 6.0. Doctoral applicants are reviewed with regard to stated interests and objectives and the ability of the Department to provide a quality experience for the applicant.
