

Important Note:

Hello School of CLAD Graduate Students:

Please do apply! We cannot award you funding -- if you do not apply.

Apply by March 1.

Scholarships are offered every spring.

Read the School of CLAD Funding page for necessary links and information.

Just to clarify:

Students who are enrolled in online graduate programs tend to only take 1-2 classes per semester as they are working full-time.

Please note that online graduate students do NOT need to be registered for 9 credit hours or full-time in order to receive scholarship funding.

However, every semester you receive funding, you may receive an email from the Financial Aid/Scholarship Office, telling you that funding will not be released unless you are full-time.

Please know that the School of CLAD office will approve the funds to be released prior to the last day that tuition is due (every semester).

We do have a process already set in place with the Scholarship team to address this.

<On-campus undergraduates, graduates, and those with on-campus assistantships do have to be registered full-time.>

Online Graduate Students must be registered for one course and/or 3 credit hours.

Professional Studies (PRST) 5940 - Continuous Registration does not count.

Due to the delay in FAFSA Information, the School of CLAD Scholarships for **fall 2024/spring 2025** were offered via WyoScholarships & UW email at the end of May 2024.

Scholarships for **fall 2025/spring 2026** will likely be offered by the end of May 2025.
