COLLEGE OF EDUCATION GASHIPS AND FORMS

Funding support in the School of Counseling, Leadership, Advocacy, & Design (CLAD) comes in form of college-level graduate assistantships (GAships) and College-level scholarships. Students are encouraged to submit a **Graduate Assistant Interest Form** ASAP (to the department of interest) upon their admittance to increase chances of securing funding support.

You may also write a cover letter if you choose (and just have it ready to go). Please pay attention to the details and requirements to apply for each job.

These Graduate Assistant jobs are **not** guaranteed, and only so many positions are available to the College of Education students every year, due to availability of funding.

Please DO plan for other economic resources (including governmental aid) to assist you in pursuing your graduate degree.

Whenever we hear of a GA ship job, we will email the new incoming students, first.

Currently, UW does not have a list serve or job posting page for GA Jobs, but we hope to in the future. To locate a GA ship on the UW campus, **you will need to put in some leg work!** ☐

I would suggest calling and/or emailing specific departments or places on campus that interest you and inquiring with them if they have a GA jobs available. Please note, the department may not have the funding secured until right before the semester begins.
