Master of Science in Counseling: Clinical Mental Health Counseling Track (Academic Year 2024-2025):

(a) Number of Graduates:

- Twenty-two (22) students graduated from the Master of Science in Counseling program, Clinical Mental Health Counseling track in Academic Year 2024-2025.

(b) Completion Rate:

- Completion rate for students in the Master of Science in Counseling program, Clinical Mental Health Counseling track, was approximately 100% for Academic Year 2024-2025.

(c) Licensure or certification examination pass rate:

- In Wyoming the National Counselor Exam (NCE) is required exam needed to obtain the Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) licensure credential through the Wyoming Mental Health Professions Licensing Board.
- To the best of our knowledge, for Academic Year 2024-2025, the licensure or certification examination pass rate for students/graduates in the Master of Science in Counseling program, Clinical Mental Health Counseling track was 100%.

(d) Job placement rate of students/graduates:

- To the best of our knowledge, for Academic Year 2024-2025, the job placement rate for graduates of the Master of Science in Counseling program, Clinical Mental Health track who were actively seeking employment was 100%.

Master of Science in Counseling: School Counseling Track (Academic Year 2024-2025):

(a) Number of Graduates:

- Sixteen (16) students graduated from the Master of Science in Counseling program, School Counseling track in Academic Year 2024-2025.

(b) Completion Rate:

- Completion rate for students in the Master of Science in Counseling program, School Counseling Track was approximately 88.2% for Academic Year 2024-2025.

(c) Licensure or certification examination pass rate:

- In Wyoming no specific exam is required for school counseling licensure/certification through the Wyoming Professional Teachers Standards Board (PTSB)
- Some school counseling students elect to take the National Counselor Examination (NCE), which is required to obtain the Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) credential in Wyoming.
- To the best of our knowledge, for Academic Year 2024-2025, the licensure or certification examination (e.g. NCE) pass rate for students/graduates in the School Counseling track was 80%.
