

## Academic Year 2024-25 Strategic Plan Executive Summary & Progress Report

## **Executive Summary:**

In 2024–2025, the Division of Communication Disorders made strong progress toward the 2023+ Strategic Plan. We sustained gains in external funding competitiveness (Objective 1) and secured significant new awards. Objective 2 was achieved through faculty-wide adoption of evidence-based teaching strategies, ensuring students are well prepared for an evolving speech-language pathology workforce. Student success initiatives (Objective 3) advanced significantly, with one subobjective fully met and the other nearly complete, requiring review of just one remaining student policy/procedures document. Engagement and service to Wyoming (Objective 4) continued to be a hallmark of our mission, with excellent progress on both subobjectives and plans to sustain outreach through clinical services and consultations across the state. Overall, the Division has met or is on track to meet all objectives, maintaining strong momentum toward the three-year targets.

Overall, these achievements underscore our Division's strong progress towards the established three-year targets outlined in the 2023+ Strategic Plan.
