The University of Wyoming Assessment Matrix: A Curriculum Mapping Tool

Why would our department/program participate in the pilot and use this matrix versus another software tool?

- Developed at UW,
- Provides a visual representation of the distribution of a program's student learning outcomes across Bloom's Taxonomy.
- Provides an archival record for a curriculum - syllabi, instructor reflections, data points, pre- and post-student knowledge surveys, transfer of knowledge.

What is the time commitment/expectation involved?

- Time commitment depends on the need and desire of the program participating. If you have curriculum maps already developed in your program it will take less time than if you are starting without an existing curriculum map.
- Ideally, what really makes this work is teams versus individuals in pilot groups, but it depends on the program/department.

What type of support is available?

- Members of the ECTL Assessment Team as well as Dr. Francois Jacobs will be available to work one-on-one with programs piloting the matrix.
- Periodic check-ins will also be established with each pilot group.

Will our department have an opportunity to provide feedback and share our experience?

- Yes - this will most likely take place in May/June 2023.

Will we have access to the work developed using this tool after the pilot?
