PHASE III PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Your Residency placement will provide you with the best possible academic experiences as you pursue a teaching career. Our goal is to provide you with a quality classroom experience, in which you will have the opportunity to learn from a master teacher, to try out your own teaching style, and to have professional supervision throughout this process. Your placement will be determined by the UW faculty and school district personnel and the availability of quality mentor teachers in the school districts. The Teacher Preparation and Advising Office provides logistical support for the placement process but has no part in the determination of your Residency placement.

The following are guidelines for Phase III placement:

1. The School of Teacher Education faculty are in the process of identifying a wider range of Residency (student teaching) placement options available for spring 2019. Once these sites have been determined, a link to an online survey will be sent to your <u>University of Wyoming email address</u>. In the survey, you will provide your preferences for placement within the options available.

You will need to complete this Placement Preference form within the specified timeframe in order for your Phase III application to be complete. Without timely completion of this online survey, your application will not move forward in the placement process. If you have extenuating circumstances and wish to be considered for a specific placement site, it will be necessary for you to provide by email any supporting documentation as well.

- 2. All field experiences associated with Phase IIIa/b will occur in your assigned Residency placement district. You will complete EDEL 4109, 4309, 4409 (Methods) in the fall semester and EDEL 4500 (Residency) in the spring semester with the same mentor teacher in the same Partner School district.
- 3. You will not be placed in the same building you attended as a student; in a building where your children are enrolled; in a building where your spouse or other relative is employed; in a building where a relative is attending school; with a cooperating teacher who is a relative. Phase III students will not be placed in a parochial school (United States Court of Appeals, Eighth Circuit 1986, Stark and Sentz, Appelees v. St. Cloud State University Appellant).

Final placements are determined by the school district in collaboration with the _UW Elementary and Early Childhood Education Department.
