WHEREAS, the Faculty Senate's Academic Planning Committee (APC) has reviewed the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the APC has recommended the approval of the degree program, noting:
that the Gray's data indicates there is potential in the online mode that the department also is ready to embrace. That important parallel mode of delivery can only take place with a thoughtful reconsideration of the relevant outreach funding model for this case, which we encourage;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that it supports the recommendation of the APC as applied to the undergraduate B.A. in European Languages, Literature, and Film Studies as outlined in the accompanying proposal documents.
