11 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW
12 Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the following:

14 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
15 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
16 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the regulations; and
17 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including
18 determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 21 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
22 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
23 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and

25 **WHEREAS**, the University’s Routing Process for new or revised UW Regulations includes review by the
26 Chair of the Faculty Senate; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the changes to this Regulation have important implications to the University Faculty and to
29 the welfare of the University; therefore,

31 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate:
