To support, expand, and diversify Wyoming's economy through outdoor recreation, tourism, and hospitality industries. We achieve our mission by:


- Supplying diverse workforce training products to students and industry professionals




Timeline



Inter-Tribal Tourism Summit

- 80 attended, 27 presenters, three field trips
- Goal: to create more awareness, understanding, and discussion around the impacts and opportunities of tourism on the sovereign nations and inhabitants of the Wind River Indian Reservation


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Applied Research


- 2023 Wyoming Outdoor Recreation Report
