Students must take all courses required for this minor for letter grade and receive a grade of C or above in each course.

**1. Required Courses**

The minor in human development and family sciences provides students with coursework that can enrich and complement their primary area of study, and a foundation in the basic principles and knowledge of human development and family sciences. Students must complete a total of 22 hours of coursework, including three required courses list below:
