Tutoring Resources Available

If you haven't taken advantage of UW's tutoring resources, now is the time to check them out.

STEP Tutor Center

- One-on-one tutoring in over 50 subjects including Math, Biology, Chemistry, and Physics.
- Students can attend tutoring through Zoom and in-person.
- STEP Tutoring offers tutoring in two locations: Coe Library, Level 1, and the basement of Washakie Dining Center.
- Appointments are required and can be made through the Penji app at web.penjiapp.com.

Writing Center

- One-on-one help on papers, lab reports, resumes, job applications, etc.
- Writing Center consultants can help students understand writing assignments and brainstorm ideas for papers.
