PROTECTING UNIVERSITY PERSONNEL AND PROPERTY THROUGH INSURANCE AND CLAIMS

- This course will outline the insurance and self-insurance UW has to protect University personnel when acting in a UW role and to protect University property on campus and away from campus. The course will also cover how claims are handled at UW start to finish including filing the claim, investigating the claim, paying or denying a claim, and looking at who is involved and what their responsibilities are at each step of the claim process.

SAFETY ON CAMPUS

- This training will cover University processes and procedures related to asbestos safety, lab safety, OSHA, imports and exports of toxic substances or biological materials, radiation and biological safety, and research with animals and human subjects. It will also provide information regarding the appropriate departments and representatives to whom safety issues should be reported.

HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)
