

UW International Partnerships, Spring 2020

From 2020, UW will differentiate its international partnerships into four distinct categories, 1.) *Strategic Partners*, institutions with whom UW has multifaceted areas of cooperation (e.g., student mobility, research, faculty & staff exchange, etc.), 2.) *Transnational Education Partners*, institutions with whom UW operates collaborative degree programming or related linkages, 3.) *International Network Partners*, institutions with whom UW has shared membership in an educational consortium or network, and 4.) *Educational Mobility Partners*, institutions with whom UW has established bilateral exchanges, affiliations, sponsorship agreements, or other arrangements that enable student mobility. Memoranda of Understanding are not included here. Overtime, it is expected that UW's partners will more explicitly align with the internationalization strategy around Regions, Themes, and Partnerships.
