Interview survey utilities that are combining and organizing datasets across multiple platforms, validating data, and maintaining data security before carrying out treatment optimization efficiency projects.





Inventory and characterize the quality reliability of typical utility data sets (SCADA data historian, customer billing, capital assets such as service line material, LIMS, etc.) and expected level of effort to prepare the data sets for ML, AI, or reliable data mining. Identify which data sets might be of greatest use in the future so utilities can prioritize investments in improving data quality reliability.
