This challenge is specifically designed to bridge the infrastructure gap faced by small street vendors who play an essential role in providing fresh fruits and vegetables to millions of households.</p> <p>Selected pilot projects may receive grant funding of up to USD 450,000, with a 10% co-financing requirement. Participants will also have the opportunity to test and validate their solutions in a new market, collaborate with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and key local and international stakeholders, gain visibility among governments and financiers across Asia and the Pacific, and create measurable impact.</p> |                                                                    |

The call expects a high level of innovation and aims to support activities addressing technical risks linked to the demonstration of new technologies and solutions.</p> <p>Supported projects may focus on optimising technology processes and operational parameters or improving the characteristics of products and solutions. Innovation projects should demonstrate a net-zero technology or solution in an operational or virtual and industrially relevant environment at Technology Readiness Level (TRL) 6-7, without requiring large-scale demonstration or commercial production at this stage.</p> <p>PowerUp NetZero has allocated EUR 1,615,000 to support innovation projects, providing financial support for at least 14 projects.
